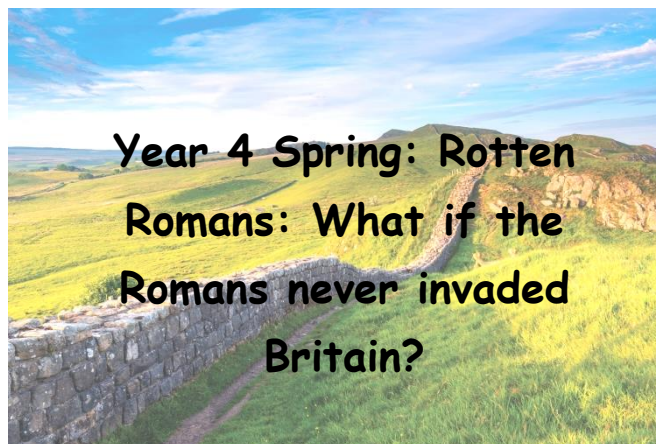
Compare images of Boudicca
