

Communication and Language

- Tell familiar stories using pictures as prompts.
- Answer open ended questions.
- Teach new skills to friends
- Recall and define specialist vocabulary for the half term.

Physical Development

- Use woodwork tools to cut and join safely under supervision.
- Safely use a wider range of food preparation tools (e.g. chopping board, knives, graters and a fruit squeezer).
- Control small games equipment.
- Travel across more complex obstacle courses, including changes of height.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Work in a small group to play turn taking games.
- To solve problems using our words.
- Make healthy snacks

Mathematics

- Count forwards and back within 20.
- Make comparison of length and height using non standard measures.
- Demonstrate composition of 6,7 and 8 with pair wise and five wise patterns.
- Subitise to 5.
- Sort 2D shapes by their properties.
- Narrate the pattern of a week, using the names of the days.

Literacy

- Understand why an event happens in a story
- Predict the endings of books
- Listen to more complex Nursery Rhymes
 - Play word play songs
 - RWI set 2 sounds
 - Write simple sentences using regular words, including diagraphs

Understanding the World

- Interpret Google Street View from school to the bakers.
- Name features on the route to the bakers and navigate right and left turns on a line.
- Identify similarities and differences between babies and 4 year olds.
- Describe how people change in the first four years of their life.
- Identify similarities and differences between 4 year olds and adults.
- Describe how people grow up and change.
- Describe the roles of significant adults in the community.
- Sequence the life of a baby bird from hatching to maturity.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Make considered choices to create mix media or relief design in clay.
- Speak and act in role of members of the community e.g: Shop keepers Reverend Lee
- Create your own story map or scene from a story.
- Re tell episodes from a known story with dialogue using small world figures or puppets.
- Memorise short dance sequences.
