English/writing opportunities

We will be learning about the tragic sinking of the Titanic during spring 1. Year 6 will write newspaper reports and a flashback story about the disaster.

In spring 2 we will be write persuasive letters from the pov of a shark detailing the atrocities they face in the ocean, and explanation texts about natural disasters.
